

For 2023 DSA-Sec Exercise

- Submission of additional documents (scanned documents, photos, images & videos) must be done by
 - uploading the documents of large file size e.g. videos, photos or images, you wish to submit in your own Google Drive or Dropbox **FOLDER OR** by pasting the scanned documents onto a WORD doc, saving it as a single document/file and then attaching as a required document when you complete and submit the “e-Form For Submission of Additional Documents”.
 - labelling the folder/document with “Full Name of Student_Primary School_Talent Area Abbreviation” e.g. Siti Raihana_Earth Pri Sch_EL OR ChloeLimSiEn_Water Pri Sch_MEP.
- For submission using the Google Drive or Dropbox FOLDER
 - copy the link and ensure that anyone with this link can VIEW the documents.
 - submit this link directly to RGS by completing the “e-Form For Submission of Additional Documents” for the relevant talent area.
- Shortlisted applicants will be notified of the date and time of their in-person selection trials/auditions/interviews via email.
- Please note that meeting all criteria does not guarantee the applicant will be shortlisted for selection trials/auditions/interviews or given an offer.
