

## Frequently Asked Questions for *Year 1 Posting Results and Y1 Registration*

**1) What do I do after receiving the Y1 Posting results?**

Posting results will be released on Tue, 22 Dec 2020 via the MOE website, SMS and your daughter's primary school. Due to the Safe Management Measures for Covid-19, there will not be physical reporting at RGS, unlike in previous years. Instead, all students posted to RGS will complete their Y1 Registration **online**. Parents will receive instructions via Parents Gateway or email on Tue, 22 Dec 2020. All posted students to RGS will then complete their Year 1 Registration the next day through a link that would be sent to them.

**2) Is there an information package or any forms that I need to complete? Would I be able to collect the forms and the information kit before the release of the posting results?**

The information package and forms are available on the RGS Year 1 Registration website and the link will be sent to parents of 2021 Year 1 students. There is no need to collect any hard copy forms from the school.

**3) Can I buy uniforms and books at RGS?**

Due to the Covid-19 safe management measures, students and parents should refrain from coming to RGS to buy uniforms and books. They are to make online purchases and arrange for home delivery or collect their purchases from the respective stores. More details can be found in the Year 1 Registration website.

**4) Is there an orientation programme for Secondary 1s? If so, when will it be and what will happen then?**

There is an orientation programme for all Secondary 1 students. (In RGS, we refer to these students as 'Year 1s' as they are in 'Year 1' of the 6-year Raffles Programme.) Orientation Week in RGS begins on Mon 4 Jan 2021 and will end on Thu 7 Jan. More details will be provided on the Year 1 Registration website.

**5) I cannot decide whether to take up a Third Language or an Elective Programme. Is it possible for me to register for a Third Language and also interview for an Elective Programme to keep my options open?**

It is strongly recommended that students consider their options carefully and adhere to the deadlines to submit their choice. In RGS, it is not possible to take both a Third Language and an Elective Programme as our timetable is planned in such a way that lessons for these programmes are scheduled simultaneously only on Friday afternoons. Thus, your daughter cannot be in two programmes at the same time.

**6) What are the Elective Programmes offered in RGS and what are the pre-requisites for application?**

Information on these Elective Programmes can be found on our school's website and more details will also be shared on Year 1 Registration website. You are strongly encouraged to go through the details on the website to find out more and not to miss the application deadlines.

**7) How many CCAs can a student take up?**

In RGS, all students only take up one CCA. This is to ensure that all students have a well-balanced RGS experience where they can also make time for other learning opportunities. On average, every CCA has activities on at least two days of the week and, therefore, students are unable to take up more than one CCA.
